## **Colon Procedure**

## **Pre-operative Instuctions**

- 1. Do not eat or drink anything after midnight the day before surgery.
- 2. Start your colon prep the day before the procedure at 8 am. Drink clear liquids for the rest of the day. Let the pre-operative nurse know if you bowel movements are not clear the day of surgery.
- 3. If you have blood pressure medications or other medications that are necessary to take every day, it is OK to take them with a sip of water the morning of surgery around 6 am.
- 4. If you are on medications that thin you blood (warfarin, Coumadin, Plavix ®, clopidogrel, Arixtra, St. John;s Wort, etc.), please contact the office to obtain specific instructions. Otherwise stop all of these medications 5 days prior to surgery.
- 5. Aspirin 81 mg is OK to take if it is the only blood thinning medication you are taking.
- 6. If you are a diabetic and on diabetic pills, do not take these pills the morning of surgery.

## Call The Crawford Clinic right away if:

- You develop a fever over 101.5°F (38.5°C).
- You become dizzy and faint.
- You have chest pain.
- You have nausea and vomiting.
- You become short of breath.

## Call during office hours if:

- You have questions about the procedure.
- You want to make another appointment.
